Amateur photographers from as far as Strathalbyn and Murray Bridge joined members of Tailem Bend's Photography Group on their twilight field trip of the town's iconic Round House, Friday November 15, 2019.

With very little left of the large semicircular Round House, photographers were left to imagine the loud, echoing sounds of metal on metal and the bustling drama of locomotives moving from their maintenance bays via the enormous circular turntable.

Launching his drone from one of the rail yards, Glenn Power of Tailem Bend was staggered with the size of the complex.

"I've been in the yard before, but it was only from the air that we could really appreciate the sheer scale of the complex – it was some engineering feat for its time," he said.

EDITH 'DOT' RICHARDS


When we talk about Taillem Bend legends or legends anywhere, it's impossible to go past Edith 'Dot' Richards.

Mrs Richards was interviewed by the MV Standard when she was 98 years of age and I quote partly from that interview: **At the time, her car was 47 years old and she still loves her 40 year old wood fired oven.

PICTURED RIGHT - She still drives around the town safely behind the wheel of her beloved Morris Minor and because of her journeys to the Main Street, everyone knew her.

Dot did say at her recent test the instructor said he was very impressed with her driving and that was enough for her to remark that she will continue until she is physically unable.

Her mother was ill and passed away when she was young and her Auntie and Uncle brought her up, "I class them as my Mum and Dad," she said. At the age of 23 she married her late husband, Arthur Richards. As Arthur worked for the railways, the couple moved around the area before settling in Taillem Bend in 1936. They had three children - one boy and two girls and her husband passed away in 1971 and her son in 1988.



"I've lived a pretty quiet life on my own and looked after myself and still do," she said.

She still enjoys her social life and drives down to meet her three friends every Saturday at the Main Street Hotel for a quiet stout and a bet on the horses, but does detest the pokies.

After talking to some of 'Dots' friends it was obvious they had great respect for her. Neighbour Mike Langcake, said she had a strong memory and a great sense of humour and he enjoys his weekly visits to her saying she can definitely look after herself.** Source MV Standard.

I had the pleasure of meeting with and having a chat with the two members of the Richards family, grandson Rodney and daughter Kay. They passed on many stories about 'Dot' for this article.

Edith Richards was born on the 6th April 1906 and passed away 9th February 2009. She was born in Naracoorte and spent her early years working on the family farm at Wolseley where she rode a horse to school and spent time milking cows, training horses and competing in equestrian events. The milk was taken by horse and buggy to the Wolseley Station - while loading the heavy cans, she met her future husband Arthur James Richards, who offered to help her.

They married in 1929, her husband was a railway man and for most of his life carried the nick name 'Dick'. They moved from Wolseley to Wirrega, Cooke Plains, Pt Adelaide and then made their final move to Tailem Bend, taking up residence in a cottage where she was to live for the rest of her life. The sale yards were just across the road from their cottage and Edith often helped out milking the cows that were yarded there. She also made pasties for the girls who worked in Trevena's Bakery, who preferred to eat hers and not the Bakery's. (Jim Trevena would have not liked that !!)

Edith gave up driving when she was 98 years old after having a bad fall and as a long standing member of the community she was made a life member of the Senior Citizens Club.



Skilled tradesman, accomplished speedway driver, musician, singer, entertainer, radio personality and all-round good guy, Bobby Hunter has brought so much excitement, pleasure and entertainment into the lives of so many.




Port River Dolphin Cruise


In addition, the Community Passenger Network (MMCPN) offers services to transport disadvantaged people living in the District Council areas of Coorong, Karoonda East Murray and Southern Mallee. Word is out in the community and eligible people of all ages are now making the most of our friendly and efficient, volunteer driven comfortable cars, to attend medical appointments that are outside of the hours and areas serviced by the Medical Bus, or to access such things as shopping, banking, visiting family or friends, attending events etc. Community Passenger (CPN) transport is door to door, from your home to your destination and back again.

Please note: The Medical Bus will not be available between December 13th 2019 to January 13th 2020, while they take a well earned break. The Community Passenger Network will also give our volunteer drivers a break from December 23rd, resuming January 6th 2020.

One of our “frequent flyer regulars” from Meningie sometimes adds a stop at McDonalds for lunch, a bank visit, and / or a spot of shopping to his transport trip while in Murray Bridge! 



Pangarinda Botanic Garden

Banksia cuneata a very rare specie occurring naturally in the central wheat belt of Western Australia, has been flowering at Pangarinda Botanic Garden throughout spring - I am often asked, "is it really a *Banksia*?" as the flower resembles a *Dryandra* flower. Pink and cream unopened perianths displayed on the end of branches resembling matchsticks, has given it the common name Matchstick *Banksia*.

Banksia petiolaris is one of the five varieties of prostrate *Banksias* growing at Pangarinda - a spreading plant with leaves and flowers at ground level. With this plant found growing mostly on road verges in the south of WA, which



are becoming degraded through fertilizer drift and weed invasion, it is important for places like Pangarinda to keep them growing.

Banksia blechnifolia another of our prostrate *Banksias*, with the beautiful dusky rose red flowers borne on the ends of the creeping branches, has something that loves the flowers as much as our visitors. When in full bloom they are found lying around the bushes, something we don't know if a bird or perhaps the *Echidna*'s are pulling them off. No other of the prostrate *Banksias* are targeted.
